Brentwood, CA – 7/14/2025 - Northern California and Shepherd's Gate are proud to announce their ribbon cutting ceremony for the new campus expansion of three 2-bedroom cottage units, a new food pantry and an additional laundry room. Shea Homes has been the generous Builder Captain on this project. The cottages will provide an additional program for the women and children that have completed their 9-12 residential program on campus. The cottages will be used for clients who have found stable employment or are attending college, before becoming fully self-sufficient graduates of the program and moving into local affordable housing. Also, this additional program will give children the opportunity to remain in the same school as they continue to receive support services while they heal from their past trauma.
