For over a year, she struggled to find food and had no medical care. She weighed less than one hundred pounds. Someone alerted our staff to Patti's situation, and we went out at night looking for her in the homeless encampments. When we found her, we started building a relationship with her.

She came to Shepherd's Gate and was able to get the medical care she needed. She had healthy meals and soon was thriving. Now Patti has stable housing and graduated our program last May!

Kristin

Before coming to Shepherd's Gate, Kristin's abuser tried to kill her. He violently beat her many times. And her young daughter

saw everything. She thought escaping her abuser was hopeless, so she tried to commit suicide to end her pain. Kristin manged to escape with her newborn baby and came to Shepherd's Gate, while her daughter stayed with family. Thanks to friends like you, Kristin overcame her struggle with addiction and found healing from the terrible trauma she experienced.

Even better, Kristin, her newborn and her daughter were reunited. Through the kids' program, her daughter got child-specific therapy to help her process her own trauma. Now the family is building a new future. Kristin has a job and is taking college classes.



Caitlin

Caitlin's struggle with addiction caused her to lose custody of both her sons. She was desperate to escape her addiction and

be a good mom. She came to Shepherd's Gate and began working on her recovery.

We worked with Child Protective Services so Caitlin could have visits with her boys. They saw the hard work that she was putting into changing her life.

After several months, Caitlin was awarded custody of her boys!

Since graduating, Caitlin has found a full time job, an apartment and a car. She's continued to stay sober and attends weekly recovery meetings to prevent relapses.

Best of all, she and her boys are a happy, thriving family, as they should be.





Monica

Before Monica came to Shepherd's Gate, her abuser made her live in a shed in the backyard. Her young son needed

medical care, but he refused to let her take him to a doctor. He would beat her until she was unconscious, her young son asleep next to her.

"Today is the day. Come rescue us."

When she heard about Shepherd's Gate, she called and began talking with staff, building a relationship and trust with us. One day she called and said, "Today is the day. Come rescue us."

We immediately drove out to where she was and parked our van behind a fence where she could escape without anyone seeing her. She handed her son over the fence, then climbed over. Monica was stunned as they drove away: they were finally safe.

She started college classes this fall and hopes to be a special education teacher someday. Her son is receiving the medical help he needs and is also participating in multiple therapy appointments. Monica is thriving and excited about their future.

None of this would have been possible without friends like you!
