You Helped Sherry Find a Reason to Live

HEN SHERRY* WALKED through the doors of Shepherd's Gate last May, she was at rock bottom. She had been battling alcoholism since she was 14 — half her life.

"I'm 29, and I'm alive," she said, her voice trembling. "That's a miracle."

Sherry's story is one of heartbreak and resilience.

At 14, she started drinking to escape the pain of her parents' divorce. Something traumatic also happened during this time, but it was so devastating that she has a missing block of time, unable to remember what it is.

By 18, she had a DUI and a shattered sense of self. Four failed recovery programs later, she was still trapped in the cycle of addiction.

One day, consumed by despair and suicidal thoughts, Sherry realized she could no longer care for her two young sons. She made a life-changing decision: she called 911 on herself, saying, "I can't take care of them."

Her mother arrived just in time to take the boys, sparing them from a police intervention.

That cry for help became a turning point. A friend told Sherry about Shepherd's Gate, and she made the call that would change her life.


Strength and Purpose for Sherry, Through Your Support

Sherry clings to a note her grandfather wrote before he passed away: "You are the one God has chosen to bring faith to our family." Today, she's living out that calling. "I know forgiveness is precious," she shares, "because it brings us home to God."

Building Futures, One Cottage at a Time

The Cottages at our Livermore location provide a crucial support system for graduates of our program who are attending college or transitioning to the workforce. Our vision is to replicate this at our Brentwood campus.

Our Brentwood advancement projects have been funded by a few generous donors who saw God's vision of our three-phase approach. We are so blessed to have a new learning and career center, after-school room and a playground.

We have just broke ground on our last phase to build three cottages and a new pantry. Also, we will be remodeling our old pantry into a new bedroom for new guests.

All of this will allow us to help an additional 15 women and children.
